TT Rockstars Quick Guide

Garage in this area the children play individually and are given times tables questions. Using their answers the computer determines which times tables they need to work on.

Studio is a game they play individually and gives the children times tables from the 1's up to the 12's.

At the top of the page there are a number of buttons the first is play which brings up all the times tables games the children can play.

Shop – This is where the children are able to spend the coins that they earn from each activity.

Battles this shows the children which battles they have taken part in.

Band this shows the child the rest of the children in their year group.

Garage in this area the children play individually and are given times tables questions. Using their answers the computer determines which times tables they need to work on.

Studio is a game they play individually and gives the children times tables from the 1's up to the 12's.

Sound check is where the children play individually and are set 25 questions in the style of the Year 4 times tables test that they complete during the summer term.

Festival is where the children can play times tables against other children from around the world.

Arena is when the children can play against other children in their band.

Rock slam is where the children can challenge another child from their band.

When the children play on any of the games there is a guitar at the side which moves them up a rock level as they play this actively encourages the children to gain more coins. Once the children have completed each activity they are told how many coins they have gained and their rock speed per question.
