Phonics

Reception (F1s)- Focus: 'ou' sound

This lesson will take place in the Google meet today!

Nursery- F2s Focus- Oral blending and segmenting

This lesson will take place in the Google meet today!

Nursery- F3s (Minnie, Corey and Ella) Focus- **environmental sounds.**

We continue with sounds in the environment this week. This week we would like the children to make some sounds while they are out and about. This could be out in the garden or whilst you are out for a walk.

-Find a stick and find all the different sounds it can make by tapping it on different surfaces, along a fence, along a wall or against a tree

-Jump in a puddle

-Snap a stick

-walk across some leaves

-Squelch in some mud

Encourage the children to describe the sounds that they make.

Literacy

Starter (all children)- Watch the video on Tapestry of Mrs Wells reading 'How to grow a dinosaur'.

Recalling the story

What was your favourite part of the story? What did Alby grow?

Activity (all children): Design your own seed packet.

In the story Alby grows a jelly bean tree and a lot of scary dinosaurs. *What would you grow if you could? Maybe a flower that is made up of cakes, some fairies or a unicorn!*

Draw (or ask an adult to draw) a large rectangle to be your seed packet. Inside your rectangle draw a picture of what your seeds will look like and what they will grow into. (I have uploaded some pictures of Alby's seed packets onto Tapestry).

Think of a name for your seeds and write the name at the top of your seed packet.

I cannot wait to see what your magical seeds turn into!

F1s- Have a go at writing the name of your seeds by yourself.

F2s - Can you sound out and hear all the sounds in the word 's-ee-d'? Copy or trace the name of your seeds.

F3s- Trace the name of your seeds

Maths

Reception children

This week we will be looking at the **building the numbers 9 and 10**. This is more than just counting, but also understanding how they are represented, can be composed and sorted in different ways.

Today we are starting with representing and sorting 9 and 10. Watch Miss Cooper's lesson found here;

Following on from the lesson complete the activity. You will need to make some tens frames using found objects from home e.g. sticks, straws, pipe cleaners, or strips of paper. Counters could be buttons, coins, raisins etc.

Nursery children

Focus: Counting

Singing number songs is a great way for the children to learn counting and it is fun to do together. Encourage the children to show the correct number of fingers as they sing.

Topic

We are going to be using the internet to find out about dinosaurs today using Junior Google;

Encourage your child to use the keyboard to type in 'dinosaurs' and any questions they want to find out into the search bar. If you call out the letters they can find them on the keyboard and type them in. This is tricky but it is good practice for children to recognise capital letters!

Can they find answers to these questions;

How many different types of dinosaurs were there?

What was the longest dinosaur?

What was the smallest dinosaur?

What was the heaviest dinosaur?

Can you find a dinosaur joke?

Finish off by practising mouse skills by playing some dinosaur games;
