

FSU Home learning Term 3 Week 3
Friday 22nd January 2021

Dear Parents,

The website issue has been resolved now, so hopefully all plans will be accessible on it again. Phew! Thank you for your patience with such things we are having to learn new things as we go to!

I am looking forward to meeting the **Reception Children at 9:30 am** and the **Nursery Children at 10am** on Google Meet today. The link has been sent by email. We are going to have a Scavenger Hunt, so please prepare your children to move about to find some things.....

Phonics

Reception (F1s)

You will need the speed sound flashcards you made last week and all the 'ar' word cards.

Lesson:

--Revise this week's sound- Ask-what this week's new special friend? Can they remember the rhyme for this sound? ('start **the** car')

-Speed sounds- With the 'ar' flashcard in the pile show each sound one at a time for your child to name. Note any they are finding tricky and repeat these. (In school the children put their hand up when they spot this week's new sound.)

Fred Fingers-Ask the children to tell you how many Fred Fingers each of these words have :**star, sharp, hard** and **start**. Get the children to show the fingers and lightly pinch each one as they sound out the word. Then say the whole word. E.g. 'star' has 3 Fred Fingers: s-t-ar....star.

Hold a sentence- **It is hard to start a star**

As yesterday: use 'My Turn Your turn' to repeat sentence several times until they can remember it well enough to write. Repeat the sentence as they are writing if necessary and emphasize the sounds as needed to help them sound the words out. Check that they are forming the letters correctly as they write, and starting at the right place.

Nursery (F2s) Alliteration

Tongue twisters

Ask your child to say-"We wear wet wellies." Repeat it faster and faster until you can't say the words anymore! What sound do these words begin with?

Now try "Lovely lizards love life" and "Happy hippos hide honey". Can you make up any more with a different starting letter? (The sillier the better!)

Literacy

All children

Like last week we are going to try Hot Seating again. This time the three Bears and the Wolf. All children can have a go at this activity with an adult (and extra adult or siblings if possible!) We loved seeing the videos of children doing this last week!

Remind the children how you did it last time with one of you being a character from Goldilocks and the other asking questions to that character.

Today we are going to choose one of the three pigs or the wolf to be in the Hot Seat. For example if the child is going to pretend to be the wolf you could ask them questions like:

Why did you try to blow the little pigs house down?

Was it easy blowing the house of straw down?

How much puff did you have to use for the house of sticks?

How did you feel when the house of bricks didn't blow down?

Perhaps you could swap over then?

Maths

Reception (F1s) Alive in 5

Starter- What number have I rolled?

Use a dice. Ask your child to roll the dice and name the number of dots shown.

Challenge- say one more/ one less than the number rolled.

Main activity-

Session 5

Nursery (F2,F3s) 2D shape

Recap all the shapes taught this week by playing a timed game.

Spread out triangles, squares, circles and rectangles of different sizes on the floor. Set a timer for 30 seconds, once the timer has started, call out a shape one at a time for your child to pick. See how many shapes they can pick up before the timer runs out.

Challenge- call out the properties of the shape rather than the name

Activity-

Give your child some lengths of string and ask them to make the different shapes
