#### **Primary School Place**

#### Is you child 3 or 4 years old?

Primary school place - you must apply now

If your child was born on or between 1st September 2014 and 31st August 2015 you need to apply for a primary school place now. You must still apply even if your child already attends a nursery attached to the school. Deadline for applications is 15th January 2019.

Apply online at www.oxfordshire.gov.uk/admissions

It's quick, easy and secure. You can get free access to the internet at many libraries and children's centres. Alternatively, we would be happy to help you in the school office. Paper copies of the application form are also available from the office.

The Admissions Team at OCC recommend that parents apply online where possible, as the school offer will be sent via text on the day. Where applications are made on paper, letters are sent to by second class post on allocation day so may take some time to reach parents.
