Reading records are checked on a Monday.

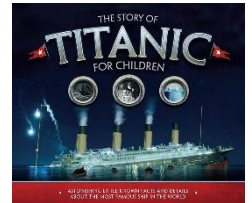
PE is on Tuesdays. Forest School is Thursday.

English

Our book this half term is 'The History of the Titanic'. It is a non-fiction story that discuss the famous ship's construction and its disastrous maiden voyage.

The children will be creating their own Titanic project anthology with a collection of different genres of writing including narrative, non-chronological reports, diaries, poem and newspapers.

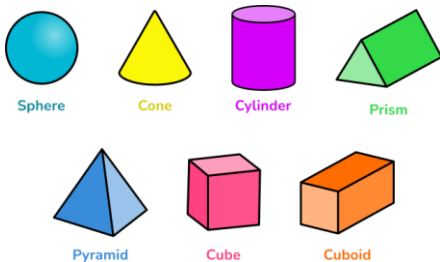
It will be a chance for the children to explore how to apply ambitious punctuation and vocabulary in different contexts.



Maths

This term we will be focusing on algebra in Year 6 and shape.

We will spend some time looking at different types of graphs and charts.



Science

This term we will be looking at Classification. Children will focus on the following content:

- describing how living things are classified according to common observable characteristics
- studying similarities and differences of plants and animals
- classifying a range of microorganisms
- giving reasons for classifying plants and animals based on specific characteristics

History

We will conduct a study on the different inventions and discoveries of the Maya civilisation including writing, calendars and buildings.



Art

This half term, children will be making Mayan masks using our history knowledge of Maya Gods.



Computing

Children will be learning all about webpages. Children will be able to create their own website!

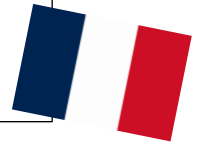


PE
