We had a wonderful drama workshop with 'Perform' on Wednesday and all acted as explorers in the jungle.

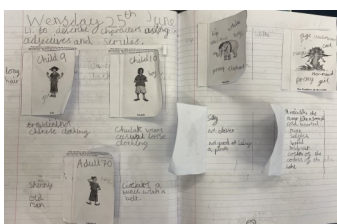
We also talked about money in PSHE and role played a bank and made our own cheques etc.

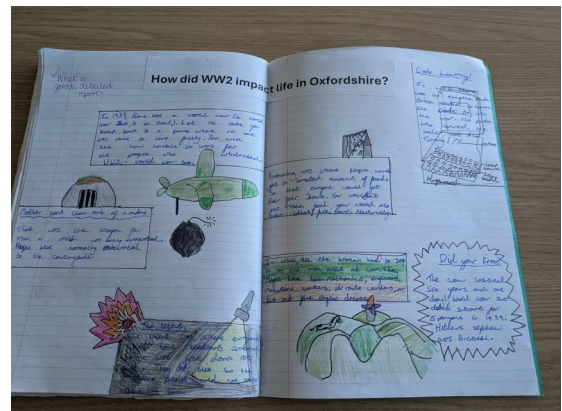
