What focus from SDP is driving this visit?	Objective 4: To promote and embed the school's Christian values
Classes / Staff visited	Mrs Amanda Clarke – RE Leader Walked around the school Visited every class
What we observed	<p>I met with the RE leader at Charlton-on-Otmoor – Amanda Clarke.</p> <p>We walked through school to observe evidence that we are a Church of England school. This required us to look at the reflection areas in each classroom.</p> <p>We also discussed the Diocese Scheme of Work which is used in school to support teachers with the planning of lessons.</p> <p>We looked at children's work in Key stage two to see the examples of work being produced in class.</p>
What we were most impressed with:	<p>The FSU reflection area was brilliantly organised with age appropriate resources laid out.</p> <p>The year 3 and 4 books showed clear learning objectives, teacher and student assessment, independent work and regular input.</p>
Suggestions moving forward:	<p>We discussed how we could add more evidence around the school to show we are a Church of England school. For example putting a name and status of the school on the door window, the feasibility of adding a Church of England sign to the staff noticeboard and adding a new logo on collages in entrance and in hall.</p>
