

8.45a.m. – 3.15p.m.


- Families are asked to arrive each morning and wait on the playground.

SATs

Year 6 will take national curriculum tests in English reading, English grammar, punctuation and spelling and mathematics in May 2023.

The tests help measure the progress pupils have made and identify if they need additional support in a certain area. The tests are also used to assess schools' performance and to produce national performance data.
